



APPLICATION FOR THE ACSD RESEARCH GRANT

If an ACSD Research Grant is awarded, the researcher agrees to present their findings to the membership in the form of a workshop at an ACSD annual conference and/or an article for publication in the *Growth Journal*.

APPLICATION

1. Describe the nature of the research in an abstract of 300 words or less.
2. Describe how this topic contributes to the field of student development or higher education.
3. How much research money will you be requesting? (up to \$750)
4. Give a tentative accounting of how the money will be used to accomplish your research (i.e., printing costs, postage, transcribing, etc.).
